Dear Mr. Gressett:

This will confirm the conversation between yourself and Mr. L. McCutcheon regarding the possible flaring of gas on our J. H. Everest No. 1 in the Atoka (Penn-Gas) Field on Sunday, June 15, 1969.

The Everest No. 1 presently produces approximately 80 BWPD while flowing at a 2 MMCFPD rate. A shut-in of the well will require a lengthy swabbing period to restore production.

Transwestern is planning an 18 hour shut-down of their system on June 15. We are attempting to make arrangements with Transwestern, so that flaring will not be necessary. If it is required, we will flare only a minimum amount.

Your cooperation in this matter was deeply appreciated.
