The Commission was organized by the New Mexico Legislature in 1913. Its purpose was to investigate the oil resources of the State and to recommend measures for their conservation. The Commission has since that time been actively engaged in its work, and has issued several reports to the Legislature. This report is the first of a series of reports which will be issued by the Commission during the year 1914.

The Commission has been very fortunate in securing the cooperation of the various oil companies operating in the State. These companies have furnished the Commission with all the information which they have been able to obtain regarding their operations. The Commission has also conducted extensive investigations of the oil fields of the State, and has secured a large amount of valuable information regarding the same. This information will be used by the Commission in its future reports to the Legislature.

The Commission has also been very active in promoting the conservation of oil. It has issued numerous pamphlets and leaflets regarding the same, and has held many public hearings on the subject. The Commission has also been very successful in securing the passage of legislation which will tend to conserve the oil resources of the State. This legislation includes the creation of the Oil Conservation Fund, the establishment of the Oil Conservation Commission, and the enactment of the Oil Conservation Act.
