We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows: Rotary rig

to a depth of 1000 feet, then and finish well up with spudder, to a depth of approximately 1150 feet.

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Blanket Bond of \$10,000, filed with Commission in name of Martin Yates, III

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil and gas sand should occur at a depth of about 1100 feet.

In the event we encounter commercial oil pay, plan to cement 7" Casing from top to bottom, with 200 sacks of cement, circulating cement to top of pipe, or surface of ground,
