
Gentlemen:

On March 16, 1959, a survey was made to locate your No. 3 location on the USA Malco Refineries "B" lease at a point 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Elddy County, New Mexico.

A flag was set at the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 1 and 2, and the Transit was set up at the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12. Thence Chaining North from transit a distance of 660 feet, thence East 660 feet to the Location Site of the USA Malco Refineries "B" No. 3. As a check on our survey we chained South from location 660 feet and West 660 feet to the point of beginning checkin in within 0.30 foot, within the allowable error for this survey.
