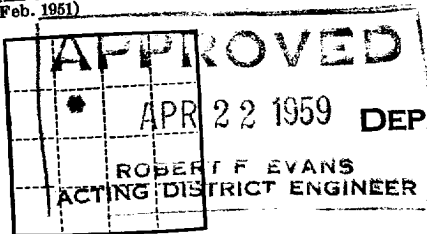

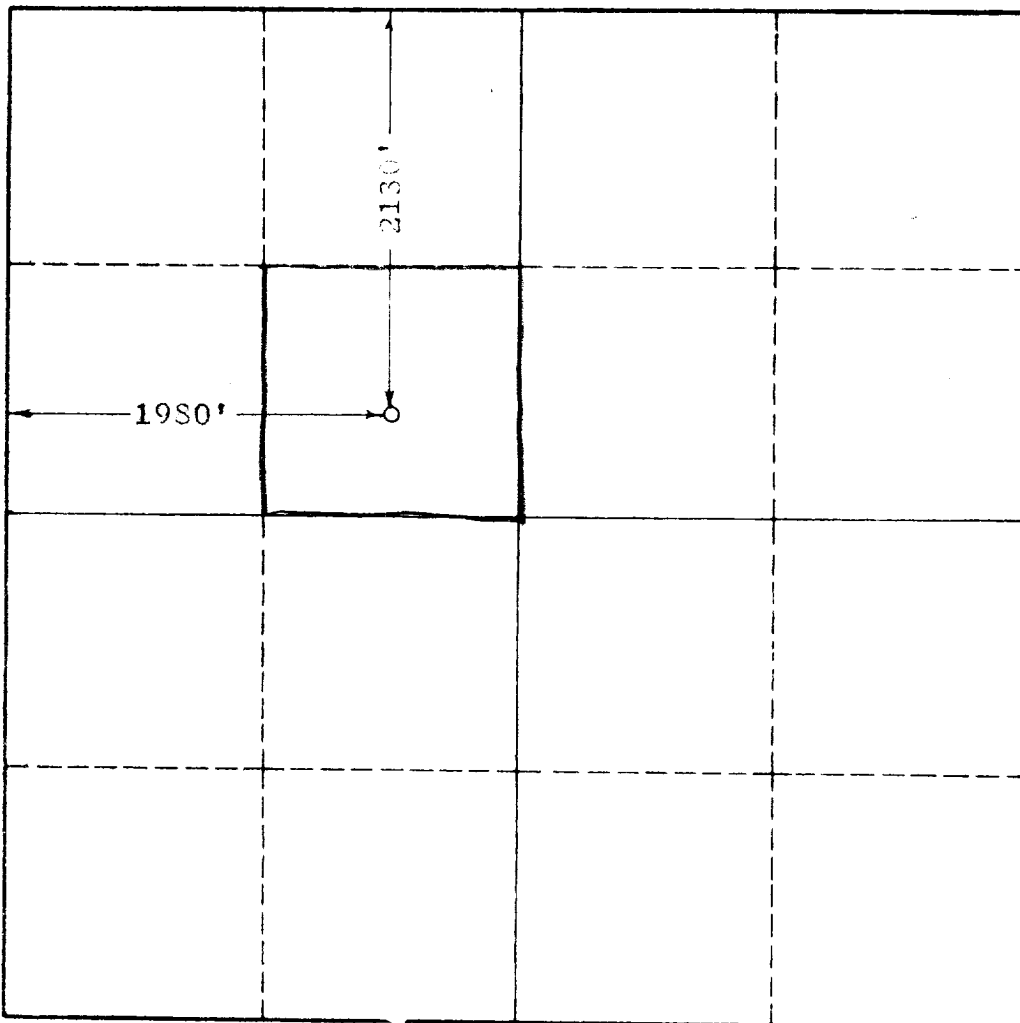

Gentlemen:

On April 18, 1959, a survey was made to locate your No. F-4 location on the USA Malco Refineries "F" lease at a point 1980 feet from the North and 1980 feet from the West lines of Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

A flag was set at the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 1 and 2 and the Transit was set up at the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 1, 2, 35 and 36. Thence chaining South from Transit 1980 feet, thence East 1980 feet to the location site of the USA Malco Refineries F No. 4. As a check on our survey we chained North from the location site 1980 feet and West 1980 feet to the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 1 and 2, 35 and 36, checking in within the allowable error for this survey.

On April 20, 1959, we were told that the location had been moved 150 feet South to an offset stake that we had put in on the original survey, making the location of the USA Malco Refineries F No. 4 at a point 2130 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West lines of Section 1, T18S, R27E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.
