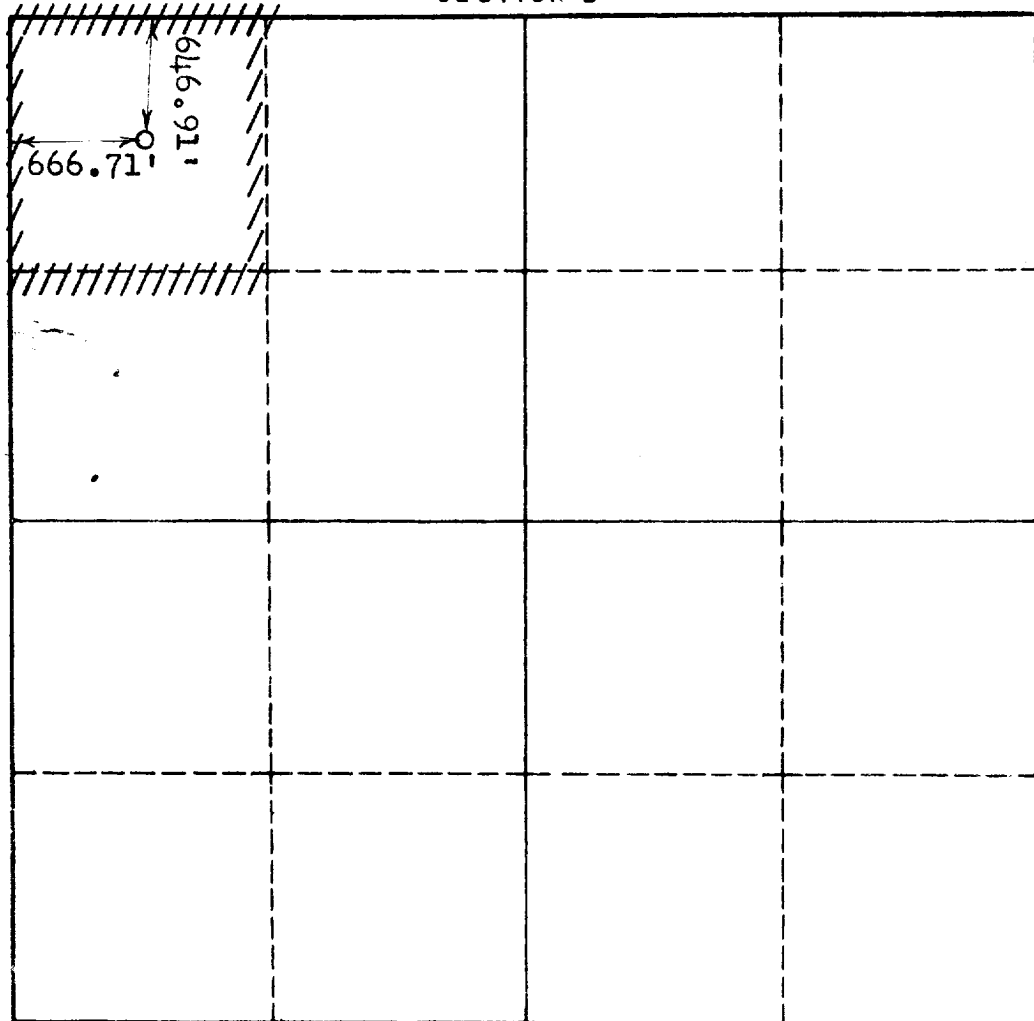

Gentlemen:

On September 10, 1959, a survey was made to locate your U. S. A. Malco Refineries, Federal "F", No. 10 oil well to a point 646.91 feet from the north line and 666.21 feet from the west line of Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, New Mexico Principal Meridian, Eddy County, New Mexico.

A flag was placed on the north quarter corner of Section 1, and the transit was placed over the point common to Section 1, and 2, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, and Section 35, and 36, Township 17 South, Range 27 East. We then chained south 0 degrees, 48 minutes east, a distance of 666.21 feet to a point marked by a 2 inch by 2 inch wood hub with a tack; thence north 89 degree, 22 minutes east, a distance of 646.91 feet to the location of the well marked by a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch Steel pin. To check we then chained back to the above mentioned wood hub; thence 0 degrees, 48 minutes a distance of 1975 feet to the above mentioned quarter corner.
