## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Above well was acidized with 1000 gals by Halliburton on the above date. Used 15 % acid and maximum pressure built up was 675 lbs on casing, which broke down to 500 lbs. and took acid at this pressure very freely. No results obtained whatever although it looked like a good acidizing job.
