FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This is an abandoned well drilled by Brainard & Guy to a depth of 625'. We plan to deepen this well to the regular Empire Pay, approximately 1650'. Our casing program will be to set the 7" O.D. 50' into the lime, which should be around 1100' to 1150', cementing same with 25 sacks of cement, preceded by aqua gel.
