

Gentlemen:

On August 6, 1959, a survey was made to locate your No. 1 location on the State of New Mexico "BA" lease at a point 990 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West lines of Section 2, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

A flag was placed on the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 2 and 3, and the Transit was set up on the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 34, 35, 2 and 3. Thence chaining South 990 from Transit, thence East 660 feet to the location site of the State of New Mexico "BA" No. 1. As a check on our survey we chained North 990 feet from location site and thence West 660 feet to the point of beginning of the survey, checking in within the allowable error for this survey.
