Spudded 12-1/4" hole 11-24-58. On 11-26-58, 8-5/8" (1003' of 24# J-55) was set at 1006' and cemented with 575 sacks 2% Gel plus 100 sacks neat circulated. After WOC 36 hours, tested casing before and after drilling plug with 1000 psi for 30 minutes, no drop in pressure. Resumed drilling operations.
