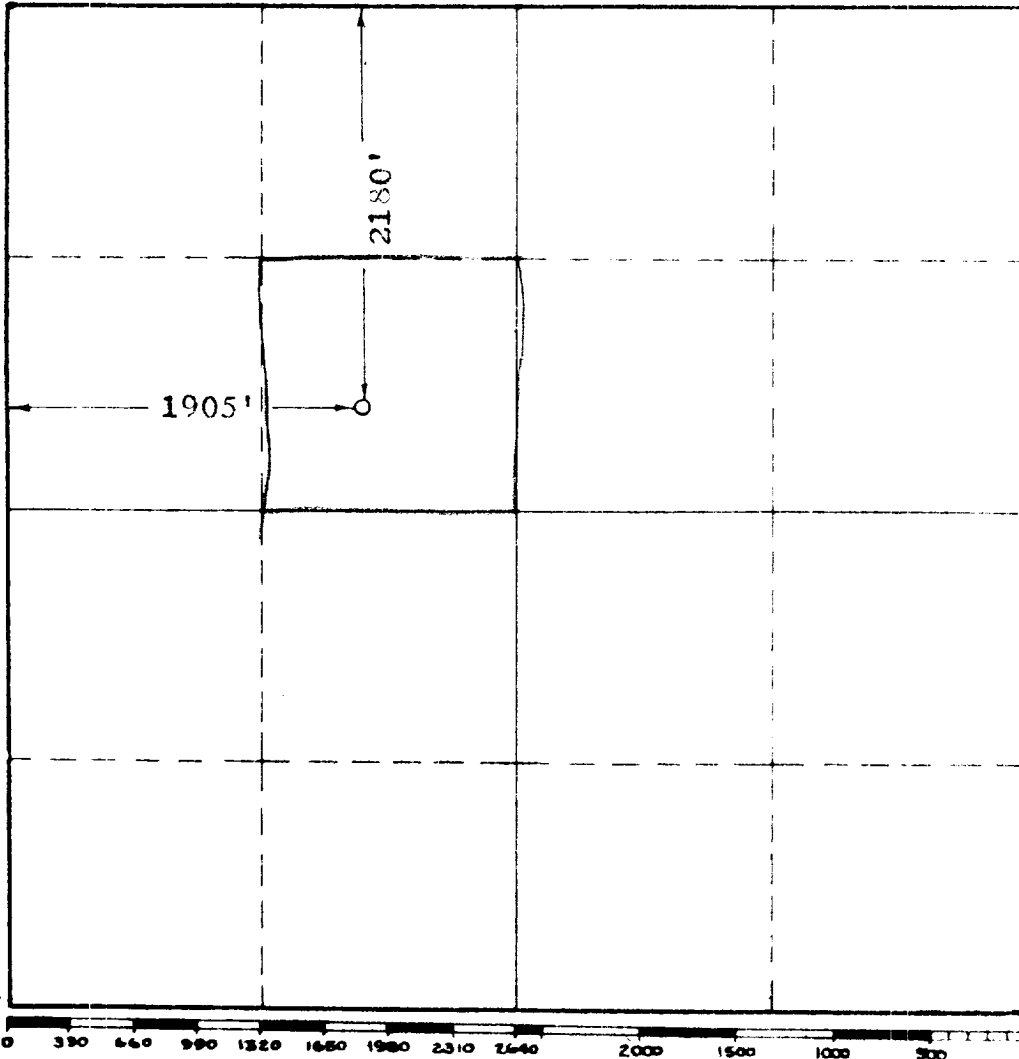


On December 27th, 1958, a survey was made to locate your State "AT" No. 3 Well location at a point 1980 feet from the West line and 1980 feet from the North line of Section 2, township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

A Flag was set at the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 35 and 2 and the Transit was set up at the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 34, 35, 2 and 3. Thence chaining East 1980 feet and thence South 1980 feet to the Location site of the State "AT" No. 3. As a check on our survey we chained North from Location site 1930 feet and thence East 650.1 to the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 2 and 35 checking in within 0.40 foot of the USGLO Distance for this section.

On December 29th, 1958, Pan American Supervisors moved the location site 200 feet South and 95 feet West making the location 1905 feet from the West line and 2180 feet from the North line of Sec. 2, T18S, R27E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
