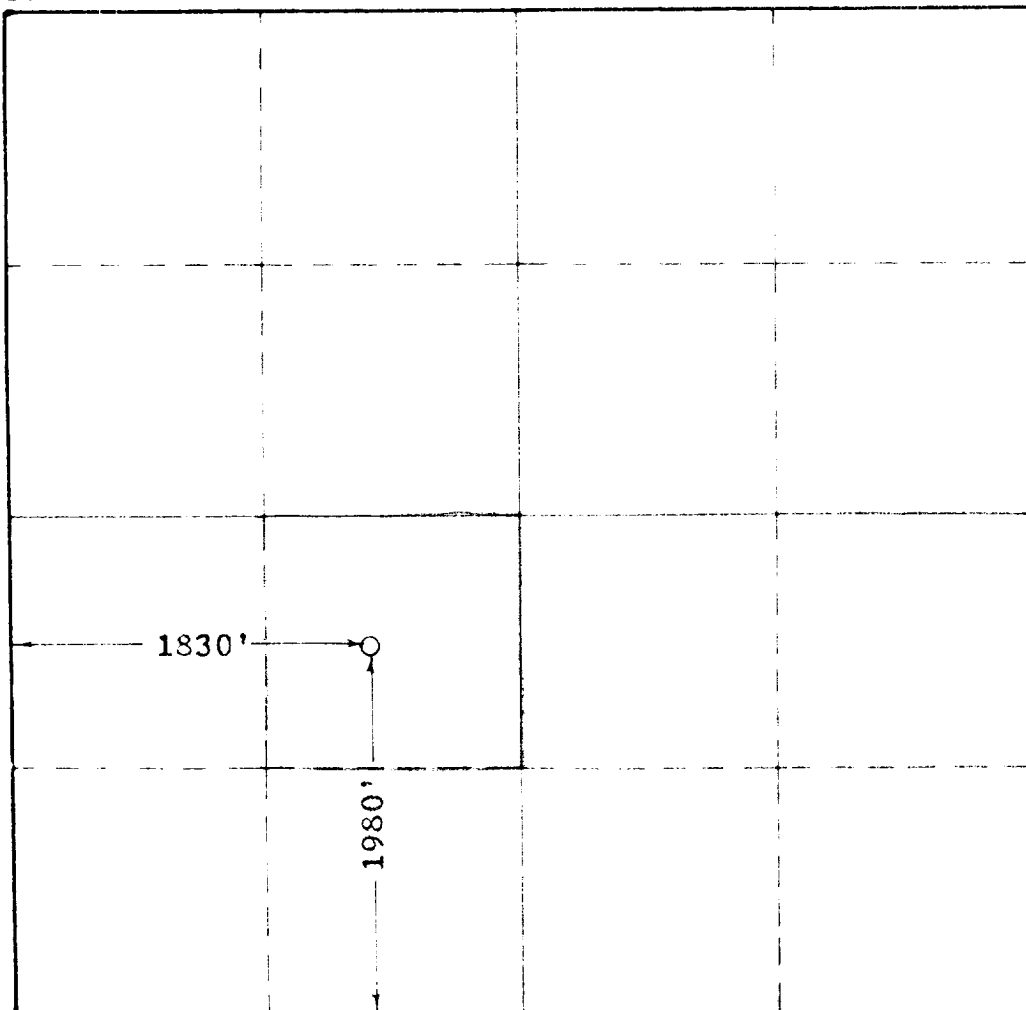


On October 17, 1958 a survey was made to locate your No. 1 location on the State of New Mexico "AU" lease at a point 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 2, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County New Mexico.

A flag was set at the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 2 and 3 and the Transit was set up at the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11. Thence chaining North 1980 feet from the Transit (a Hub at this point used in staking the "H" No. 1 in Sec. 3) thence East 1980 feet to the location site of the State of New Mexico "AU" No. 1. As a check on our survey we chained South 1980 feet to a Hub on the South line of Section 2 which was used in staking the "A" No. 2 in Sec. 11, checking in within 0.20 foot of the other survey which is within the allowable error for this survey.

We were notified on October 22 that the location site of the State of New Mexico "AU" No. 1 had been moved 150 feet west making the new location site 1830 feet from the West line and 1980 feet from the South line of Section 2.

I hereby certify that the foregoing survey was made in the field under my supervision and that the same is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
