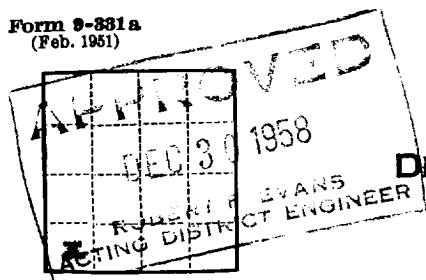

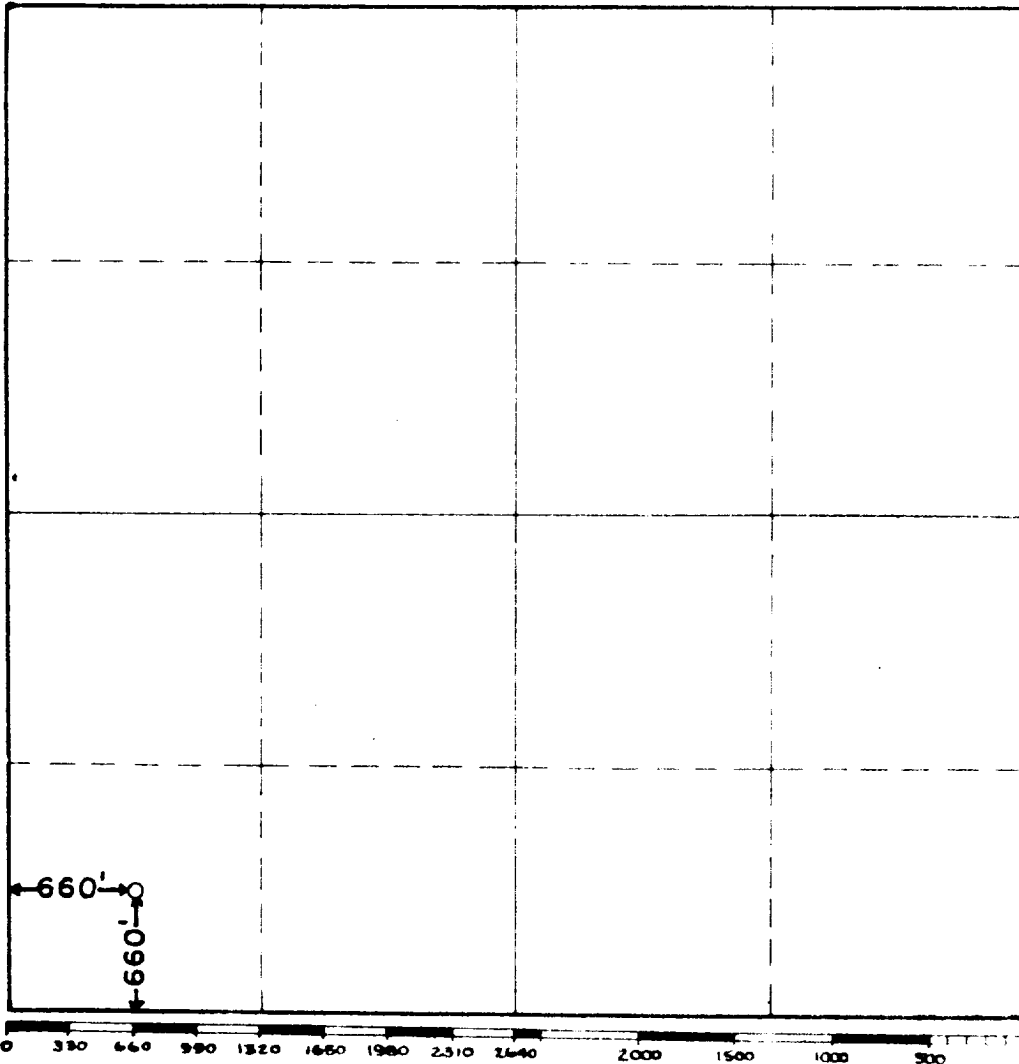

Gentlemen:

On December 23, 1958 a survey was made to locate your Windfohr Federal No. 1 Well at a point 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 3, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

A Flag was set at the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 3 and 10 and the Transit was set up at the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10. Thence chaining S88°35'E 660 feet from the Transit and N0°38'W 660 feet to the location site of the Windfohr Federal No. 1. As a check on our survey we chained N88°35'W 660 feet and S0°38'E 660 feet to the point of beginning of our survey, checking in within the allowable error for this survey.
