This well was formerly the Pan American Mallee "Q" No. 1 located in Section 4-188-27E, Eddy County, N.M.; a deep well drilled to approximately 10,000 feet and abandoned. The well has been recompleted in the San Andreas Formation.

On October 15, 1962 well was placed on pump and pumped for approximately 30 days, pumping and recovering approximately 72 barrels per day of frack water. After oil started to show up and after ten days, the well was making approximately 20 barrels of oil and 40 barrels of water. We have our tanks full at the present time and waiting on pipe line connection. We still do not have back all the frack water.
