We plan to run 680' of 8" to shut the upper water off; approximately 900' of 20# seamless 7", cemented to surface to comply with Water Board regulations; setting 4-1/2" casing at approximately 1850', cemented back into 7". We plan to pull the 8" after running 7".

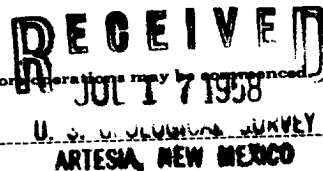
This hole will be drilled with cable tools and the contractor will be C. L. Bowen, Star Route East, Artesia, New Mexico.

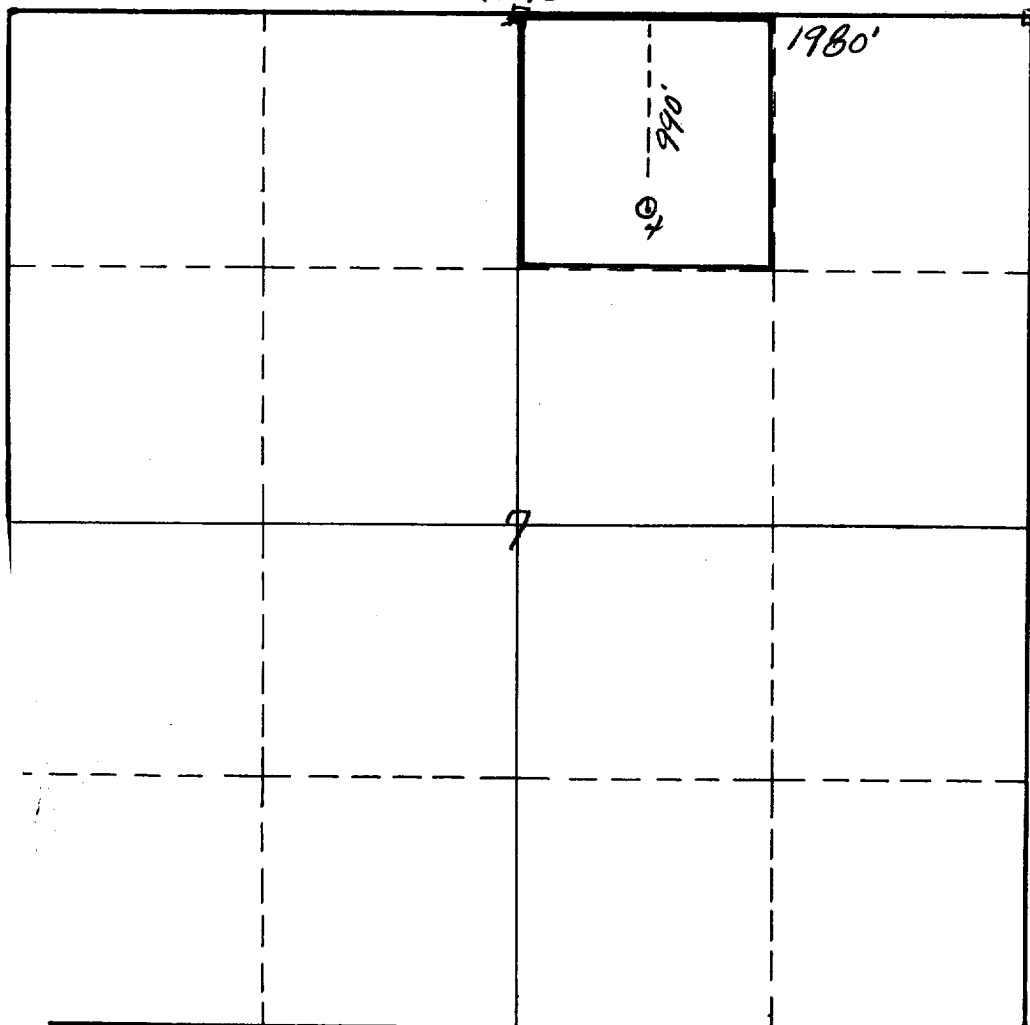
