Upon reaching 150', bore hole increased from 11-inch to 8 feet in diameter below substructure with complementary cracks in surface around rig. South side of derrick was sinking. Skidded rig to prevent cratering.
Cemented hole and surface with 150 sacks of cement. Set 4" pipe marker.
Pits and location will be used for No. 1-X well.
