Dear Mr. Neel:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of July 26th, regarding the well in Section 7, T. 18 S., R. 27 E., which Mr. A. A. Kaiser wishes to convert into an artesian well.

I find that a "Notice of Intention to Drill New Well" was submitted to this office by Mr. W. A. Scott for this well which was designated as the Kaiser Well # 1. This Notice is dated May 27, 1952. It was approved by Mr. J. D. Hunter, State Oil & Gas Inspector, provided an acceptable surety bond in the amount of \$1,500.00 was filed with this office. However, no bond was filed by Mr. Scott and hence the drilling of this well has never been finally approved by this office.

Under the circumstances, it will be quite satisfactory for you to take over this well and handle it as a regular artesian well independent of the State Geologist. We will be relieved to know that it will be properly handled from now on and that no damage will result from failure to plug it as an oil test.
