Dear Sir:

I am writing you in regard to your Gilbert lease wells #1 & 2, in Unit K of Section 7-T18S-R27E.

In checking your C-115 I noticed you produced from well #1-X 855 barrels and well #2 799 barrels a total of 1654 barrels during the month of December, that is 507 barrels more than your unit allowable. Unit allowable being 37. barrels of oil a day for wells #1&2.

Your allowable will need to be cut so as to make up for the over production accrued. I notified Malco Refiners, Inc as to the overage. I suggested to them they take 27 barrels a day until you were even.

I would like for you to write me a letter (3 copies) explaining why this overage accrued, and how you would like to adjust it.
