4 days at 12 barrels 48 barrels current

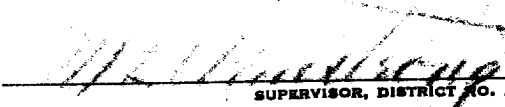
TOTAL JANUARY ALLOWABLE, 156 barrels.
