On August 28th, 1951 we ran 2" tubing to bottom of hole at 1227"; filled hole with mud, using 41 sacks and circulating to surface; spotted 10 sacks of cement on bottom to cover oil pay; shot off casing at 815" and recovered that much 7" casing; ran tubing to 1251 and spotted 10 sacks of cement. Cemented required marker with 5 sacks and cleaned up location.
