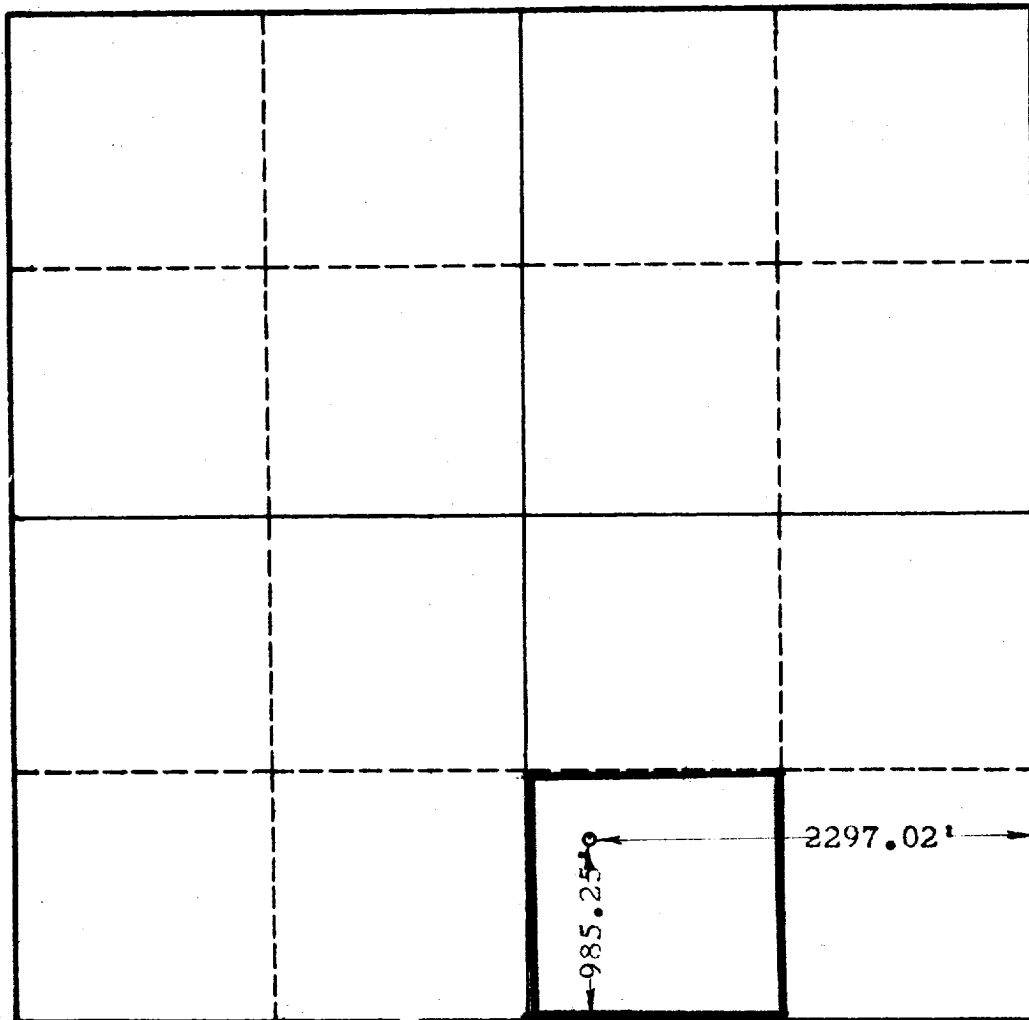


On October 27, 1959, a survey was made to re-locate your U.S.A. Malco Refineries "K" No. 2 well at a point 985.25 feet from the South line and 2297.02 feet from the East line of Section 9, Twp. 18 S, Rng. 27 E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The location site also described as being 330 feet from the North and West lines of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9.

A flag was placed on the south quarter corner of Section 9, and the transit was set up at the point common to Sections 9, 10, 15, and 16. Thence chaining S 89° 59' W a distance of 2297.02 feet; thence N 0° 23' E a distance of 985.25 feet to the location site of the U.S.A. Malco Refineries "K" No. 2 Well. As a check on our survey we chained S 0° 23' W from the location site a distance of 985.25 feet and thence S 89° 59' W a distance of 329.8 feet to said quarter corner checking in within 0.2 feet of the distance shown on the USGLO Township plats.

The aforesaid well was originally located 654.74 feet from the South line and 1973.21 feet from the East line of aforesaid Section 9.
