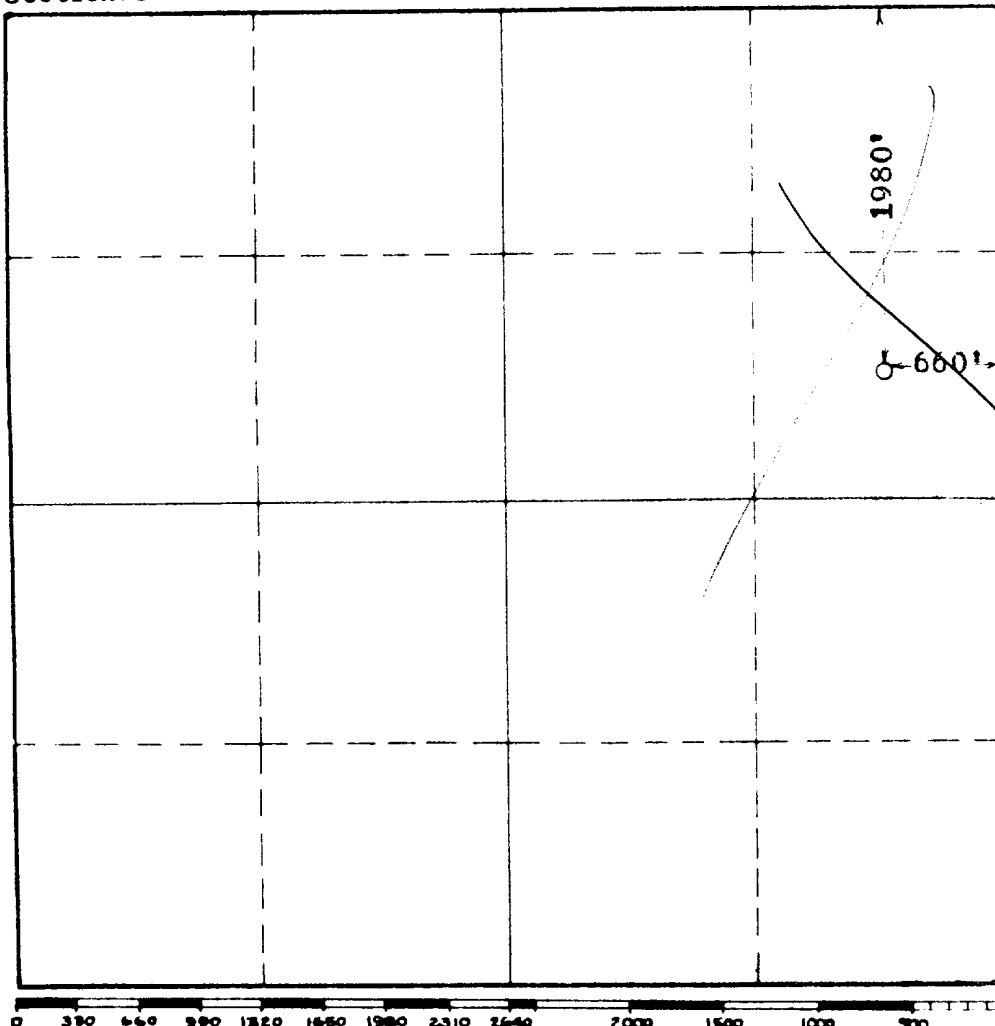

Gentlemen:

On October 16, 1958 a survey was made to locate your No. 4 location on the Malco Refineries "D" lease at a point 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 10, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

A flag was set at the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 10 and 11 and the Transit was set up at the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11. Thence chaining South 1980 feet (at this point we found a hub used in staking the "B" No. 1 in Sec. 11) thence West 660 feet to the location site of the Malco Refineries "D" No. 4. As a check we chained North 1980 and thence East 660 feet to the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11. Checking in within the minimum error allowed for this survey.
