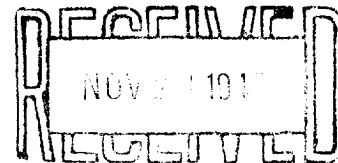

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Plan to fill hole with mud from 1800 ft. depth to 1625 feet. Then run 5 sack cement plug. Then pull the 5" pipe and fill hole with mud to 1000 feet. Then run another 5 sack cement plug. Then fill with mud to 600 feet and set another 5 sack cement plug. Then fill hole to surface and set regulation marker.
