## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On September 11, 1944, well was shot with 430 qts. of nitro (solidified) from 1770-1850 and production increased slightly.

Again on October 2, 1944, well was shot from 1395-1435 with 160 qts. of solidified, using 75 shells.

Above work was done by the New Mexico Glycerin Company of Artesia, N.M. and production on initial test of 24 hours was 64 barrels.
