(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

To plug producing zone at 1843 and convert well to fresh water by pumping 15 sacks of neat cement on bottom at 1883'. Hole to be filled with water and a 30 sack cement plug will be spotted at top of producing zone and extending into bottom of 7" casing at 1827'. An 8 sack (30 foot) plug will then be spotted at 350'. Casing will be perforated and well tested for fresh water productivity. This complies with verbal approval by Jim Wright of the State Water Engineer's office in Roswell, New Mexico. This report corrects the C-102 filed on May 15, 1959 which indicated well would be plugged at surface also.
