Pursuant to your telephone request of November 14, 1960, we wish to advise that at the present time we are $constructin_{i}$ Abo Chalk Bluff Draw Unit Tank Battery No. 2, Unit P, Sec 17, T-18-S, R-27-E, Eddy County, New Mexico. Due to excessive flow line lengths, it is economically unfeasible to use our Tank Battery No. 1, Unit F, Sec 9, T-18-S, R-27-E, Eddy County, New Mexico, for any further completion to the south on a permanent basis.

Service Pipe Line Company is transporter and they advise that they will not be tied into Tank Battery No. 2 until after December 1, 1960.

We, therefore, on a temporary basis, will produce Abo Chalk Bluff Draw Unit, wells 15 and 16, into test tanks on the lease, and move by tank truck to an additional stock tank at Tank Battery No. 1, gauge, and then run through LACT Unit to pipe line to save drayage.
