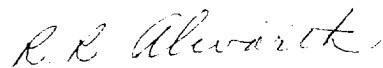
Dear Mr. Armstrong:

Gas) in Unit C; Section 17; T-18-S; R-27-E Eddy County, New Mexico, we would appreciate your allowing us to take this test during the period of annual "Turn Around" at Continental Oil Company's refinery at Artesia. In the past this has been in the Fall months of the year.

Although Well 4-F (Perm. Gas) has been shut in since initial completion, contract negotiations are now in progress to connect it to the Continental Plant fuel system. We have been using the annual plant "Turn Around" period for taking bottom hole pressures on other wells connected to this system and it would present an excellent time to take the packer leakage test on Well 4-F.
