Placed 240 qts. of E. I. Dupont S.O.W.E. #1 from 2010' to 1915' with double A.G. 24 hour bomb and Bulshevick cave catcher on top of shot from 1915' to 1911'. Bomb set for 24 hours to explode 7:06 a.m. Placed 3' of crushed brick and 5' of pea gravel from 1911' to 1903'. Dumped 10 sacks of calseal by Halliburton from 1903' to 1855'. Stemed to surface with oil. Drilling calseal at 1899'. Shot exploded at 7:07 a.m., May 13, 1950. Now cleaning out.
