T.D. 2006' with 8 5/8" surface casing at 505' with 50 sacks cement. It is our intention to clean this well out to T.D. by reverse circulation method with our Company rig, Run Gamma Ray Neutron Logs and Caliper Survey; information obtained by Caliper Survey will determine if we run and cement a string of 5 1/2" casing to T. D. or set above shot hole and sand-oil fracture with approximately 60 to 80,000 gals. with 2 lb. of sand per gal. We also would like permission to recover the 5 1/2" casing after fracture treatment depending on results of treatment.
