RE: Request for Status of Required Pit Closure Artesia Metex Ut. #47

Dear Billy J. Smith,

A field inspection made at the Artesia Metex Ut. #47 found the Surface impoundment as required by O.C.D. has not been completed.

The excavated area of the surface impoundment has visible hydrocarbon Contaminated soil in the south bank and will require additional excavation.

The removed contaminated soils are stockpiled to the east of the excavated Area and will require landfarming or blending to reach the recommended Remediation level for final closure.

After all contaminated soils are removed from the excavated pit area. Soil samples will be required taken from bottom and sidewalls which will be take to a crediable lab to determine the remaining TPH & B-Tex and Clorides levels.

Please Continue the required pit closure actions as required by O.C.D. no later than 15 days from The date listed on this letter.

Notifie N.M.O.C.D. to witness any soil sampling events that are to be taken To lab that O.C.D. may have the opportunity to witness.
