June 15, 1964 - Rig up pulling unit and hydraulic jacks to pull 13-3/8" OD casing.
(NOTE - 13-3/8" OD 8rd. 48# casing mudded @ 323')

June 16, 1964 - Jacked on casing, had to shoot off. Recovered a total of 289'
of 13-3/8" OD 8rd. 48# casing. Left 34' in the hole.

This proposed 3,000' San Andres test was temporarily abandoned at a
total depth of 323'. The location has been cleaned up and well is now con-
verted to a water well with a total depth of 323'.

There will be no marker erected at this time because of it's
conversion to water well. The water well will be operated by Mr. Jack Flemmons
of Artesia, New Mexico and it will be his responsibility to plug according
to USGS requirements upon abandonment.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
