## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon State Well  
No. 1 in ~~XXXX~~ of Sec. 15, Twp. 18 S., Rge. 27 E.,  
N. M. P. M., Artesia Oil Field, Sddy County.  
We plan to commence work on Soon, 1932.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

**Non-commercial.** When the Fisher Oil and Gas Company were pumping their wells on the adjoining lease it was possible to produce this well at a profit, but since they have plugged and abandoned their wells it is not possible to produce this well at a profit.

The present condition of the well is as follows:

216' of 10" pipe  
667' " 8 1/2 "  
1919' " 6-5/8" pipe.

**Dry hole, no water.**

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

**Fill the hole with mud laden fluid to 1600' and put in 5' of loose rock and then fill the hole with mud laden fluid to 400' and put in 5' of loose rock and set three sacks of cement, also set three sacks of cement on top of the rock at 1600' before filling the hole back to the 400' level. After setting the cement at 400' then fill the hole with mud laden fluid to the surface and set regulation marker.**
