## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was drilled to a depth of 1788' where a show of oil and gas was encountered. The hole was plugged back with 25' of gravel, a wooden plug, 6' of oakum, 150' of gravel and 5 sacks of calseal. 1655' of 7" O. D. lap-weld casing was set and cemented with 50 sacks by Halliburton. After 72 hours wait, the hole was bailed. As no water appeared, indicating a thorough shut-off, cleaning out and drilling was resumed.
