We called the BLM office in Carlsbad on April 28, 1986, and received verbal permission to pump 250 gallons of acid water in perforations made from 2,227 to 2,237 feet. These perforations were made in 1955 and at the time we acidized on April 29, 1986, it was making no oil or water from these perforations. The well is now making eight (8) barrels of oil and twenty (20) barrels of water from this treatment. The water is being hauled by Jim's Water Service. We pumped down two inch tubing and used a strato-packer on the formation.
