Well No. 16 was shut-in June, 1970, due to uneconomical operations as a result of low oil and high water production from the Premier Zone. Tubing, rods and pump were pulled and the surface valve closed. Presently our operations are focused on waterflooding the Grayburg Premier Zone, but upper Grayburg sands exhibit water-flood possibilities. Therefore, it is planned to temporarily abandon this well until an evaluation of additional Grayburg Zone waterfloods are available.
