On about August 7, 1947 plan to run approximately 525' of used 8" lap weld casing and set same directly on top of the salt with 50 sacks of cement using Halliburton Oil Well Cementing equipment.

On about August 9, 1947, after waiting 48 hours for cement to set, plan to drill plug, bail hole dry and make 4 hour bail test to determine water shut off.
