FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On about July 14, 1948 plan to plug well back from a total depth of 3391' to a plug back total depth of 2538' and shoot well as follows. 2450-2538' with 400 quarts solidified nitro-glycerin and tamp same with 20' gravel and 16 sacks cal seal and load hole with sufficient oil to cover shot and tamp by at least 100'.

The zone to be shot is now making approximately 3 barrels crude oil per day and no further shows or increases have been encountered below the proposed plug back total depth.
