DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On Jul. 27 th. 1952. we perforated 5 1/2" O.D. 20' pipe from 2435' to 2496' with 47 7/16' holes. We then ran a Halliburton H.M. packer on 2" tubing and set it in the 5 1/2" pipe at 2517' and treated the pay section from 2539' to 2556' with 1500 gal. Hydrafrac. The ferration broke down at 1800'. The Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Co. of Dunice N.M. Perforated the pipe and treated the well. After the Hydrafrac set 24 hrs. we swabed it in through the 2" tubing. After the well had returned the load oil it flowed 165 Bbls. in 33 Hrs.
