**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Sand oil treated through the casing by Bernal, Inc. with 10,000 gal. oil and 15,000 pounds of sand from 2,367' to 2,391'. Brake down at 2,200 lbs. and highest pumping pressure was 1,300 lbs. Rate of injection was 21 barrels per minute. Total lead oil was 468 barrels including treating oil.

A 24 hour test after put on production indicated 240 barrels of oil in 24 hours.
