NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Daish Well No. 2
in NW cor SW SW of Sec. 17, Twp. 18a, Rge. 28e, N. M. P. M., Artesia
Oil Field, Eddy County. We plan to commence work on
Immediately, 1934.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

well making $\frac{1}{2}$ barrel and is not a commercial producer

The present condition of the well is as follows:

1840 ft 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ casing

The work we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

**Pull the casing up to 1450' and fill to 1450' with mudladen fluid
Put in 5' of rock and set 5 sacks of cement with dump bottom bailer
pull the rest of the casing and fill hole with mudladen fluid to
500 ft and put in 5 ft of rock and set 3 sacks of cement and fill
to top with mudladen fluid and set a piece of pipe extending 4 ft.
above the ground as a permanent marker**
