## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon State-Beeson Well  
No. 1 in SE NE SE of Sec. 18 Twp. 18 South, Rge. 28 East,  
N. M. P. M., Artesia Oil Field, Bddy County.  
We plan to commence work on August 12, 1932.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

**Non-commercial**

The present condition of the well is as follows:

10"      300'  
8 1/2"      600'  
6-5/8" 1986'

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Fill the hole with mud laden fluid to the bottom of the 6-5/8" pipe then pull the pipe to 1500' and fill to 1550' with mud laden fluid, then put in five feet of loose rock and set five sacks of cement with a dump bottom bailer. Then pull the pipe on out and fill with mud laden fluid behind it to the bottom of the 8 1/2". Then Pull the 8 1/2" and fill with mud laden fluid to the bottom of the 10". then pull the 10" and fill with mud laden fluid to 225' and put in five feet of rock and set three sacks of cement with a dump bottom bailer and the fill with mud laden fluid to 100' and put in five feet of rock and set two sacks of cement and then fill to the surface with mud laden fluid and set regulation marker.
