NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Beeson Well
No. 2 in NEESE of Sec. 18 Twp. 18 South, Rge. 28 East,
N. M. P. M., Artesia Oil Field, Bddy County.
We plan to commence work on August 1, 1932.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Well makes about one-half barrel of oil per day which isn't commercial.

The present condition of the well is as follows:

Dry hole with the following casing:

10" 300'
8 1/2" 500'

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows: **Fill the hole with mud laden fluid to about 1550' and then put in about five feet of loose rock and set five sacks of cement with a bump bottom bailer, then fill hole with mud laden fluid to the 500' level and then remove the 8 1/2" casing and fill hole with mud laden fluid as we pull the pipe. Then pull the 10" and set three sacks of cement at 110' to protect the surface water, then fill the hole to the surface and set a piece of three inch pipe for a marker.**
