DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Filled the hole with mud laden fluid to 1550' and set five feet of loose rock and five sacks of cement with dump bottom bailer. Then filled hole with mud laden fluid to 500' level and then removed all of the 8 1/2" pipe possible, which was only 200'. Then pulled the 10". Recovery: 300'. Then filled the hole to 110' and set five feet of loose rock and three sacks of cement to protect the surface water. Then filled the hole with earth to the surface and set a piece of three inch pipe for a marker.
