Ran 230 qts. liquid nitroglycerin in ten 3½" X 10' and one 3½" X 15' WJ shells with AC duplex bomb on top placed from 1986' to 2100'. American Glycerin Company shooter. Bolshevik cave catcher placed from 1980' to 1986'. Hole was tamped with brick from 1976' to 1980', gravel from 1961' to 1976', 14 sacks Calseal from 1849' to 1961', and stemmed with oil to surface.
