NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Shaw & Rathke Well No. 1 in SW 1/4 of Sec. 20 Twp. 18 S, Rge. 28 E, N. M. P. M., Artesia Oil Field, Bddy County. We plan to commence work on April 26, 1933.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Non-productive.

The present condition of the well is as follows:

**Open hole 2200 feet; 1800 feet 6 & 5/8 20-pound casing;
500 feet 8 inch 24 pound casing; 250 feet 32 pound 10 inch casing;**

DUPLICATE

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Propose to pull 6 & 5/8 inch casing; fill hole with surface material to 1750 feet; set three sacks of cement with dump baler; fill hole from there to 250 feet with surface material; set three sacks of cement with dump baler; pull 10 inch casing and fill hole to surface with surface material and erect regulation monument.


