Well was originally drilled by V.S. Welch. We propose to re-enter abandoned well with cable tools and clean out to total depth. This well will be used as a water injection well for water flood operations. Approval to re-drill this unorthodox location was granted by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-966-E.


