Reference is made to your letter of February 21 to the Commissioner of Insurance, R. F. Apodaca, which letter has been referred to this Department for reply.

The bond about which you inquire is still in force for the reason that such bond is to endure until the well which it covers has a status of approved plugging by this Department, unless the operator supplies another bond to replace the bond in question.

When the principal of the bond, Mr. G. A. Grober, was in Santa Fe last spring he asserted that he was to make a test of the well covered by the bond to determine whether or not he was to produce the well or to plug it. No further information has been received from him.

A copy of this letter is going forward to Mr. Grober at his last known address.

The information about the well is to the effect that it is capable of small production, but is in a somewhat out-of-the-way location. It is suggested that you take this matter up with Mr. Grober.
