We acknowledge receipt of your letter of February 15 regarding the plugging of the G. A. Grober well #1 - SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec25 Twnship 18S Range 28E-Eddy County.

The writer discussed this with Mr. Carl Livingston of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and he requests we file form C-102 "Notice of Intention to Plug Well" setting out proposed plan of work. Mr. Livingston informs me Mr. Roy O. Yarborough, State oil and gas inspector at Hobbs, is the proper party to approve the method of plugging.

We are attaching form C-102 in triplicate, and ask that you please fill in details of plan of plugging. We will then have the form signed by Mr. Grober who, as you know, is now living in California. As soon as we have it signed by Mr. Grober we will file it with the Oil Conservation Commission for their final approval. As I understand it, as soon as they approve Notice of Intention to Plug you can then proceed with the work.

When you return this notice to us you will have had an opportunity to determine the exact cost, and we ask that you please advise us on this.
