After treatment, well made approximately 35 barrels of fluid per hour, of which approximately 10 percent was oil and 90 percent was water. Well has been plugged back to 2854' and well is being tested by pumping. Production for past 10 days has been approximately 55 barrels of fluid per day, of which approximately 11 BPD is oil. John A.
