**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

PULLED: 1300' of 6-5/8" ; 30' of 8" and 200' of 10"  
 LEFT : 18' " " ; 560' " " " 50' " " "

Filled hole with mud laden fluid to 1335'; then set 5 sacks of cement with dump bottom bailer. Then filled hole with mud laden fluid to bottom of 6-5/8" pipe, then pulled 6-5/8" and filled with mud while pulling it. Then pulled 8" and filled hole with mud laden fluid while pulling it. At 325' put in 5 sacks of cement with dump bottom bailer to protect the surface water. Then pulled the 10" and filled hole to surface and set a piece of three inch pipe extending six feet above the for a marker.
